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Last year the project involved 3 UR seniors (Kristin Schmidt, Nehal Shah, and Megan Bailey) constructing a "community profile" for the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation.

The profile includes:

- Demographics, such as population by age, race, ethnicity, education and income levels
- Breast cancer statistics, such as screening, incidence and mortality rates
- An assessment of current services for breast cancer screening and treatment in the service area
- A survey of the community's beliefs and attitudes about breast cancer through interviews with "key informants"

The profile will also include recommendations for ways in which service gaps might be addressed by our affiliate or other service providers in the region. Students will continue this data collection and the interpretation of it.

All the students need is Microsoft Excel skills, interview skills, and some GIS background and/or the ability to learn about it. There will be 3 new openings in the project for this year.
